

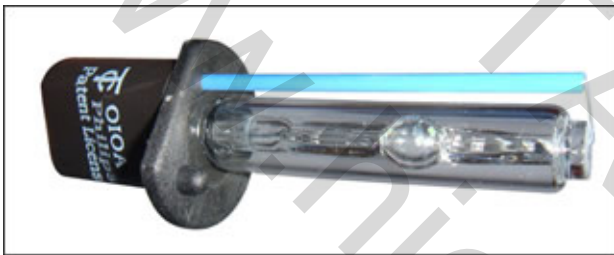
Philips Patent License

These Philips bulbs are approved by Philips and the label of "Philips patent license" on the base. Raw materials include UV-CUT Bulbs (original Philips quartz glass), electrode and Molybdenum from Sweden, pills of the United States, German xenon, 99.99% purity mercury of USA, and other materials. The colors include Golden, Sunlight, Skyblue, Cambridgeblue, Darkblue, Green or Pink, and the color temperatures include 3000k, 4300k, 6000k, 8000k, 10000k, 12000k, (25000K Blue) or (25000K Purple).

The features of Philips patent license bulbs:

- The lifespan of a bulb is over 3200 hours, compared to between 450 and 1000 hours for a halogen bulb.
- The powers are 35W and 55W, produce more light and consume less fuel than halogen bulbs.
- Offer substantially greater luminance and luminous flux, about 3200 lumens and 90 mcd/m².
- Increased safety, offer drivers more usable light than halogen ones.

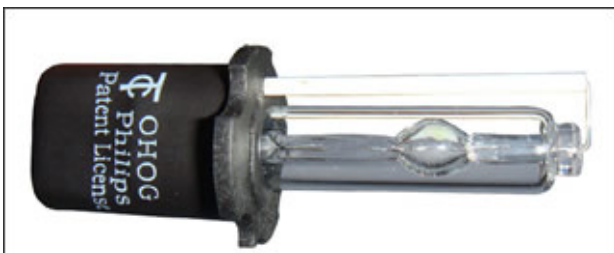
